EXAMPLES TO MODEL:

Orchestrate games/activities/situations to support language use:

"Let's play!" "I like to play cards/ games/ with you!" "Eat first, then play." "Do you want to play?" "Let's play soccer" "Do you want to play with this?" "Play time!"

"Can I play with you?" "Play some music!"

***Teach the meaning of the word *Make it fun *Repeat the word in as many ways as you can *Model using child's device or visuals *Play games *Incorporate into everyday activities**

Search for online books featuring the target word: Try Tar Heal Readers, Storyline Online. The Dr. Seuss books are great for core word learning!

Garuu Class K-2



In Garuu Class K-2 this term we have been establishing routines. Every session is started with sitting on the silver seat outside, then when we are ready we clap out a different number every time. Usually it's a number below 20, but one time we clapped all the way to 100!
